IQAC Analysis of Teachers' Feedback:

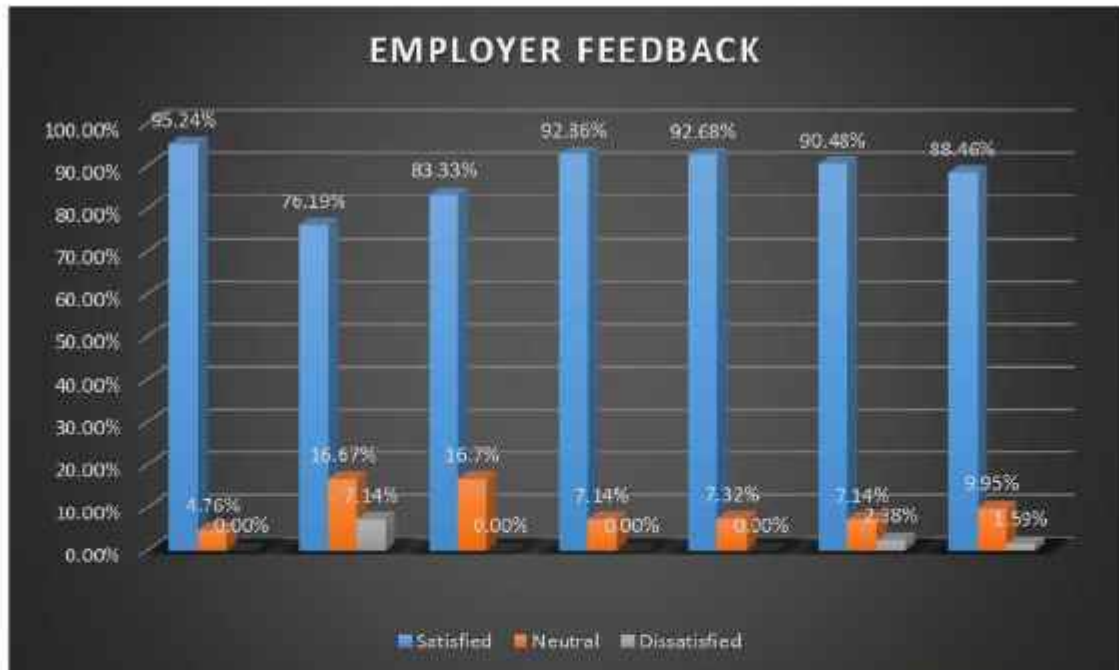
